SUGAR REFINERY MANAGER















A Sugar Refinery Manager manages and directs a team of supervisors in accomplishing the following: plan production operations; establish priorities and sequences for manufacturing products; prepare operational schedules and coordinate manufacturing activities to ensure production of product types, quantities, specifications and quality of products meet requirements.

Sugar Refinery Managers oversee the activities of production and operating workers, such as inspectors, precision workers, machine setters and operators, assemblers, fabricators, and plant and system operators. They prepare operational schedules and coordinates manufacturing activities to ensure production quality, and quality of products, meets specifications. They also reviews production and operating reports and resolves operational, manufacturing, and maintenance problems to ensure minimum costs and prevent operational delays. Other activities may include training workers in operation of equipment, examining valves, pumps, and conveyors to detect malfunctions resulting in leakage, spillage, overflow, or choke-up.
