QUALIFICATIONS

Bachelor's Degree in relevant courses like Industrial Engineering will be helpful to become a Safety Officer. The Safety Officer must be trained and accredited by the Philippines DOLE in accordance with the DOLE Occupational Safety and Health Standards, Rule 1030. (Certified Safety Officer 3 - 40hrs BOSH Training + 48hrs Advanced/Specialized OSH Training). Additionally, Basic First Aid Training and Certification from a reputable NGO like Red Cross would enhance the qualification for the role.



COMPETENCIES

Knowledge, Skills and Attributes

Technical Skills

Accountability, ability to identify hidden hazards, verbal hazard communication, and visual hazard communication. Conducting convincing presentations, providing training, and budgeting. Knowledge in regulatory organizations, how to pass inspections, and gathering and interpreting data.

Soft Skills

Critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

COST OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING



Public/State University and College average per semester

By virtue of Republic Act 10931, undergraduate students accepted to SUCs are covered for free tuition and other school fees.

EMPLOYMENT PROSPECTS

Increase in demand since 2018 and the passing of the OSH Law.

Occupational safety and health is a worthwhile career path. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the employment of OSH specialists and technicians is projected to grow 7% from 2020 to 2030.

PROSPECTS FOR CAREER ADVANCEMENT

A safety officer will be promoted to a higher level based on the number of training hours completed.

Safety officer 1 (SO1)

Mandatory 8-hour OSH orientation course applicable to its industry.

Safety officer 2 (SO2)

Mandatory 40-hour OSH training course applicable to the industry.

Safety officer 3 (SO3)

Mandatory 40-hour OSH training course applicable to the industry.

Additional 48 hours of advanced /specialized occupational safety training course relevant to the industry.

Safety officer 4 (SO4)

Mandatory 40-hour OSH training course applicable to the industry.

Additional 80 hours of advanced /specialized occupational safety training course relevant to the industry.

320 hours of OSH Related training or experience.
